Comparing his brand of Communism to a "Prince Charming." Ceausescu continued to reject the political and economic reforms sweeping Eastern Europe and reiterated his call for a meeting of Communist countries to discuss the ideological crisis confronting them. Only a few, minor leadership changes were made at the congress.
